God was calling Samuel. Once he figured out Who was actually calling him, Samuel's response was "Speak, Lord. Your servant is listening."

In the Gospel reading, we heard about how Jesus went to Simon's mother-in-law's house, because she was sick. He miraculously cured her! Then, after she was cured, she began to wait on Jesus and his

friends.
