This week, we heard the Gospel passage that told us about two of Jesus' followers who were traveling to a town called Emmaus. Jesus, who had just risen from the dead, joined them, though they didn't recognize Him. Along the way, they told Jesus about how sad and upset they were about His crucifixion and death. At that point, Jesus began using Scripture to explain why He needed to suffer, die—and rise again!

The disciples, who still didn't recognize Him, were enjoying the lesson and His company so much, they invited Him to stay with them for a meal. He agreed, and as He blessed the bread, broke it, and gave it to them, they recognized Him! Immediately, Jesus disappeared. The disciples were so excited, they immediately left, to return to Jerusalem. Once they got back, they told everyone about the Risen Lord!

Sometimes, in our journey through life, we are upset or depressed about any number of things. While it may seem like we're alone, and that everything is crumbling around us, Jesus is always with us. Even if we don't recognize Him, He is there with us.

Jesus died for our sins. Then, He rose again, to give us new life, that we can be together with Him forever. He is risen! Alleluia!
