Jesus is the Way to Heaven!

This week, Fr. Mario talked to us about Jesus' teachings in our Gospel reading. To help illustrate, he showed us a large road atlas—a map. Today's Gospel reading, Fr. Mario explained, is an expansion on Jesus' statement elsewhere that He is "the way, the truth, and the life."

Before starting out on a trip, most people like to know where they're going and how they should get there. Often, there's more than one way to get there. Maps are

very useful for finding this sort of information.

In the same way, if we want to get to Heaven, we need to know how to get there. In this Gospel passage, Jesus gives us more directions on how to get there.

One difference between directions to an earthly destination and directions to heaven is that there is only one way to get there—

through Jesus Christ, the Savior. We do that by listening to His words and following Him. As Jesus pointed out to us, He wasn't speaking on His own, but rather from His Father, the One who sent Him. So, if we listen to Jesus, we are listening to God Himself, the Creator of the universe!

Fr. Mario concluded by asking us to remember, especially the next time we see a map, that Jesus is the way to Heaven! Amen!
